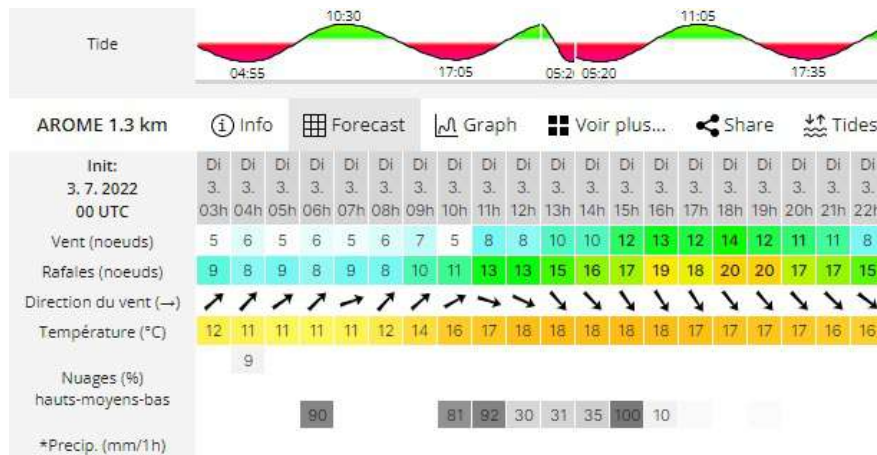




Weather forecast
